





- THIS PROJECT IS FUNDED BY A GRANT RECEIVED FROM THE ARKANSAS NATURAL & CULTURAL RESOURCES COUNCIL. IT INVOLVES THE ADAPTIVE RE-USE OF AN ABANDONED SET OF GRAIN BINS AND OTHER STRUCTURES INTO A NEW FACILITY SUPPLEMENTING THE EDUCATIONAL OPPORTUNITIES OF THE SOUTHERN TENANT FARMERS MUSEUM, ONE OF SEVERAL ARKANSAS HERITAGE SITES RUN BY ARKANSAS STATE UNIVERSITY. 
