

ABI Undergraduate Research Scholar Program

Scholar's Responsibilities

- Conduct research/project/creative work under the guidance, direction, and supervision of your faculty mentor with a work schedule agreed upon by you and your mentor. The scope of the project and the expectations of your performance are decided between you and your mentor in advance.
- Devote an appropriate amount of time and energy toward achieving academic excellence and earning an undergraduate degree in a timely fashion
- Take the initiative to communicate regularly with faculty, especially in matters related to progress within this program and your degree
- Attend the Annual Fall ABI Research Symposium (if possible)
- Present what that you learned and what research was gained by your project. This will be held prior to the end of the spring term and open to the ASU community.

Evaluation

You and your faculty mentor will receive a progress review form in December to assess your progress and performance. Ideally, this feedback will allow you to identify what is going well and the areas that could use improvement, during the second half of the program.

Payments

You will be paid by the number of hours worked on this project (10-15 per week). You will be required to submit your hours utilizing My Campus. This program will end no later than May 15.
