# **After-Action Report**

Residence Hall Fire Drills November 13, 2019

### Summary

During the weeks of September 23<sup>rd</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup>, 2019, University Safety Officer, in conjunction with Residence Life, conducted fire drills in the following Residence Halls:

Sept. 23: Arkansas Hall & Pack Place
Sept. 24: Living-Learning Community (Honors 1, 2 & 3 / Honors 4, STEM & ROTC)
Sept. 30: University Hall
Oct. 3: Sorority Houses (Delta Zeta / Alpha Omicron Pi / Chi Omega / Zeta Tau Alpha / Alpha Gamma Delta) & Kays Hall
Oct. 4: North Park Quads (Building 3 / Building 1 & 2 / Buildings 4 & 5)
Oct. 9: The Circle (Strickland Hall & Gaines Hall / Richmond Hall & Smith Hall)

The following report includes timing information and areas for improvement identified during the drills and their follow-up activities, along with steps to address the issues noted. Issues have been forwarded to the appropriate department for remedy or repair.

## Arkansas Hall

- Time required for total evacuation(s): 2:47
- Total Occupants Evacuated: 92
- Equipment Failure/Fire Code Violation: Level 2 middle stair door does not latch automatically
  - Action Step: Recommend door be replaced completely due to previous attempts of fixing the closer not being successful and the door having holes on the inside of it.
- Procedural Observations: Empty wheelchair placed in building to practice assisting persons with disabilities.
  - Action Step: Wheelchair removed during drill and placed in northwest stair, level 3.
- Procedural Observations: Some residents gathered on west side of building
  - Action Step: Reiterate emergency evacuation checkpoint to residents southeast corner of east parking lot

### The Circle- Strickland Hall & Gaines Hall

- Time required for total evacuation(s): Strickland- 3:03, Gaines- 2:21
- Total Occupants Evacuated: Strickland- 13, Gaines-15

## The Circle-Richmond Hall & Smith Hall

- Time required for total evacuation(s): Richmond- 2:50, Smith- 2:09
- Total Occupants Evacuated: Richmond- 15, Smith- 6

# Honors LLC Buildings 1,2 & 3

- Time required for total evacuation(s): Building 1-1:57; Building 2-1:53; Building 3-2:09
- Total Occupants Evacuated: ): Building 1-23; Building 2-30; Building 3-30

# Honors Building 4, ROTC & STEM LLCs

- Time required for total evacuation(s): Building 4- 2:45, STEM- 1:46, ROTC- 4:10
- Total Occupants Evacuated: Building 4- 32, STEM- 17, ROTC- 20
- Procedural Observation: ROTC & STEM evacuated to wrong side of building. ROTC had people enter building while alarm was sounding. ROTC had residents refuse to immediately evacuate, waited several minutes to acknowledge alarms.
  - Action Step: Repeat ROTC fire drill to allow for residents and RAs to better understand procedures. Remind STEM RAs of proper fire procedure.

# Kays Hall

- Time required for total evacuation(s): 6:50
- Total Occupants Evacuated: 140
- Procedural Observation: Empty wheelchair placed on level 7 in building to practice assisting persons with disabilities
  - Action Step: Wheelchair was moved to enclosed stairwell per procedure.

# North Park Quads Buildings 1 & 2

- Time required for total evacuation(s): 3:08
- Total Occupants Evacuated: 35
- Procedural Observation: Some residents entered building while alarm was sounding or reentered building before "all-clear" was given.
  - Action Step: Ensure effect communication between RAs and residents and remind residents to not go into a building with the alarm sounding under any circumstances.
- Procedural Observation: Due to size of NPQ buildings, RA's felt overwhelmed evacuating their whole floor by themselves. Did not seem confident in timeliness of evacuation.
  - Action Step: Consider adding additional staff to NPQs, look at additional training opportunities.
- Equipment Failure: Both buildings' middle stairwell doors on 2<sup>nd</sup> floor will not latch
  - Action Step: Service door and possible replace latching system

# North Park Quads Building 3

- Time required for total evacuation(s): 3:26
- Total Occupants Evacuated: 54
- Procedural Observation: Some residents entered building while alarm was sounding or reentered building before "all-clear" was given.
  - Action Step: Ensure effect communication between RAs and residents and remind residents to not go into a building with the alarm sounding under any circumstances.
- Procedural Observation: Due to size of NPQ buildings, RA's felt overwhelmed evacuating their whole floor by themselves. Did not seem confident in timeliness of evacuation.
  - Action Step: Consider adding additional staff to NPQs, look at additional training opportunities.

## North Park Quads Buildings 4 & 5

- Time required for total evacuation(s): 3:06
- Total Occupants Evacuated: 46
- Procedural Observation: Some residents entered building while alarm was sounding or reentered building before "all-clear" was given.
  - Action Step: Ensure effect communication between RAs and residents and remind residents to not go into a building with the alarm sounding under any circumstances.
- Procedural Observation: Due to size of NPQ buildings, RA's felt overwhelmed evacuating their whole floor by themselves. Did not seem confident in timeliness of evacuation.
  - Action Step: Consider adding additional staff to NPQs, look at additional training opportunities.
- Procedural Observation: Residents used nearest exit, however did not go to a common meeting place for accountability
  - Action Step: Clarify that after evacuation, residents must congregate to one area so RAs can get a headcount of how many people evacuated.
- Equipment Failure: Building 4's south hallway door would not latch
  - o Action Step: Service door and possible replace latching system

## Pack Place

- Time required for total evacuation(s): Building 1 5:04; Building 2 5:21
- Total Occupants Evacuated: Building 1 80; Building 2 70; 6 pets (both buildings)
- Procedural Observations: Empty wheelchair placed in building 2 to practice assisting persons with disabilities.
  - Action Step: Wheelchair located and moved to front vestibule by drill participant.
- Equipment Failure: Building 1 west stair level 1, push bar on exit door is damaged and will not allow door to open
  - Action Step: Service door/push bar

# University Hall

- Time required for total evacuation(s): 3:34
- Total Occupants Evacuated: 145
- Fire Code Violation: Blocking path of egress in hallways
  - Action Step: Adjust the displays in the hallways. Move pumpkins on the first floor to not block pathway.
- Procedural Observation: Empty wheelchair placed in building to practice assisting persons with disabilities
  - Action Step: Wheelchair was moved to enclosed stairwell per procedure.

### Sororities – Alpha Gamma Delta

- Time required for total evacuation(s): 1:47
- Total Occupants Evacuated: 6

### Sororities – Alpha Omicron Pi

- Time required for total evacuation(s): 2:25
- Total Occupants Evacuated: 10
- Procedural Observation: Residents were late to evacuate, did not leave building immediately upon hearing the fire alarm.
  - Action Step: Remind residents that upon hearing fire alarm, evacuation must be immediate and urgent.
- Procedural Observation: RA claimed house had been evacuated and all girls were out and then more residents came out of the building.
  - Action Step: Ensure GVAs know not to claim complete evacuation to emergency responders unless evacuation count is completely correct.

### Sororities – Chi Omega

- Time required for total evacuation(s): 2:39
- Total Occupants Evacuated: 8
- Procedural Observation: Residents congregated by back door until GVA came out of building and told them to go across the parking lot.
  - Action Step: Remind residents to evacuate to opposite side of parking lot from sorority house, at least 300 feet away from building.

### Sororities – Delta Zeta

- Time required for total evacuation(s): 1:44
- Total Occupants Evacuated: 4

# Sororities – Zeta Tau Alpha

- Time required for total evacuation(s): 1:38
- Total Occupants Evacuated: 6
