# POLICY

- Where can I find it?
- Vehicles must display department/company name & vehicle number
- Blocking paths or parking at building entrances is prohibited
- Drive only on designated paths

# POLICY

- Supervisors are responsible to ensure drivers are authorized to drive and complete training
- Arkansas motor vehicle laws apply
- National Highway Safety & Traffic Administration Standards apply
- Pedestrians ALWAYS have the right of way
- ADA accommodation is the ONLY written exception

## **BEST PRACTICES**

- Seat belts
- Keep arms & legs inside the cab at all times
- Prohibit driving in certain areas during peak hours
- If caught out in high pedestrian traffic, stop
- Avoid driving on grass

#### PATHS

- Current policy only addresses campus core
- Avoid traveling where only the cart will fit
- Take the long way
- Never park unattended in an emergency path

### PARKING

- Yellow stripes = Service parking
- White stripes = Turning radius, pedestrian crossing, passenger loading/unloading = No parking
- Red stripes/red curb = Fire lane
