

Arkansas Promise ScholarshipTM Guidelines (2019-20)

The Arkansas Promise Scholarship[™] is administered through the A-State Financial Aid & Scholarships Office. Any questions concerning the scholarship should be directed to the Financial Aid & Scholarships Office at (870) 972-2310.

Arkansas State University reserves the right to make changes to the scholarship program at any time based on available funding and eligible applicants.

What the Scholarship Covers:

- * The Arkansas Promise Scholarship[™] is a one-time award that provides \$3000 for the recipient's freshman year:
- * The scholarship is split between Fall and Spring semesters for courses at the A-State Jonesboro campus only.
- * This scholarship does not combine with any of the other ASU Institutional Scholarships is nonrenewable.

How to Qualify:

- * Students must submit an admissions application with fee, official ACT or SAT scores and an official six, seven, or eight -semester transcript.
- * Student must be a 2019 graduate from an accredited high school and an U.S. citizen.
- * Students must have a minimum ACT superscore of 23 or New SAT Total score of 1130 and a high school minimum GPA of 3.00 on an official sixsemester transcript.
- * Awards will begin in December 2018 for eligible recipients and will be awarded on a rolling basis based on funding until June 1, 2019.
- * Awards are limited and based on the availability of funding.

Student Responsibilities for Accepting and Maintaining the Arkansas Promise Scholarship[™] Award:

* Students who are selected to receive the Arkansas Promise Scholarship[™] are advised to accept the scholarship offer within 30 days; however the offer will not be revoked until July 1, 2019. If ASU does not receive acceptance by July 1, 2019, the scholarship offer will no longer be valid.

To accept the 19-20 scholarship offer:

- 2. Select SSB (Self Service) button
- 3. Select the Financial Aid link and choose Award Year 2019-20
- 4. Follow the links in the Scholarships Section to complete the following:

* Enrollment of a minimum 15 credit hours toward a Bachelor's Degree at the A-State campus in Jonesboro is required during both Fall and Spring semesters. Concurrent enrollment on another campus **cannot** be used to meet full-time enrollment status nor be paid for by the scholarship. Enrollment is locked on the 11th class day.

* Students must be seeking a Bachelor's Degree.

* All online degree programs are ineligible for Institutional Scholarships.

* Matriculation at the A-State campus in Jonesboro must occur in the Fall semester immediately following high school graduation.

* Any student who is enrolled full-time at another college, university, technical college, or branch of ASU during a regular semester (Fall or Spring) following high school graduation automatically forfeits the scholarship.

* For military exceptions, contact the Scholarships Office at 870-972-2310.

* Award holders who are dependents of ASU faculty and staff will be paid 25 percent of the scholarship value per semester for credit hours at the A-State campus in Jonesboro in addition to the faculty/staff discount.

Scholarship Renewal

• Any student who receives all Ws, Fs, WNs, Is and/or FNs at the end of the fall term will lose their scholarship for the spring term.
