Application process:

- 1- Choose which institute you want to participate in and complete the attached form.
- 2- Ask your Chair and Dean to approve the application.
- 3- Submit the application to the A-State Faculty Center, in person or at **facultycenter@astate.edu**, by April 27, 2018.
- 4- Applications will be reviewed. An email will be sent out to notify the candidate if he/she is accepted for the Summer Institute.
- 5- Registration information and sessions instructions will then be emailed to approved applicants.

Guidelines:

- Although there are a limited number of stipends available, all faculty are invited to attend the Summer Institutes.
- Only 9-month full-time faculty members are eligible for a stipend.
- A non 12-month faculty member may earn a maximum stipend of \$1200 in June and a maximum of \$1500 over the entire summer (June and July combined).
- The stipend cannot put the faculty member over his/her budgeted payroll maximum line item.
- The faculty member cannot be scheduled to teach a face-to-face class during the term they are signed up for a stipend.
- Summer Institute sessions will consist of classes instructed by A-State Faculty Center staff and invited facilitators. There will also be self-directed time, allowing participants time for hands-on project work.
- Sessions will be held in the Dean B. Ellis Library, suite 301.

What you agree to:

To receive the stipend, the faculty member must attend all sessions enrolled in or make arrangements to make-up the professional development time. Participants are expected to apply the knowledge, skills, ideas and teaching strategies learned during the summer sessions to improve their teaching during the next academic year.
