Tuition: \$202.00 per hour for a resident of Arkansas and those who qualify for resident tuition rates. \$404.00 per hour for a new non-resident.

Fees: \$10 per semester yearbook fee for full-time students only, \$5 per semester Arkansas assessment fee, \$20 per semester activity fee, \$7 per credit hour student recreation fee, \$19 per credit hour athletic fee, \$10 per credit hour Student Union fee, \$4 per credit hour infrastructure fee, \$4 per credit hour facilities fee, \$10 per credit hour technology fee, \$6 per credit hour library fee, \$6 per credit hour academic excellence fee. \$3 per credit hour deferred maintenance fee. Parking decal is \$50 annually. Some courses require additional fees not listed above. (Estimated costs per semester are based on 15 credit hours.)

OUT OF STATE SCHOLARSHIP

May be combined with Institutional Scholarships

- U.S. citizen
- Incoming Freshmen minimum 24 ACT or 1180 new SAT total and 3.000 GPA
- Transfer Students minimum 24 transfer hours and 3.250 GPA
- Equal to out-of-state tuition costs
- Automatically awarded and posted to student account upon billing
- Must be a full-time A-State student. This benefit is not available to students who attend A-State during the summer unless the student attended A-State full-time the previous spring semester.
- Be admitted to the university
 Student athletes receiving Institutional athletic aid may not qualify, please contact the A-State Athletic Compliance Officer for determination of eligibility.

Students are encouraged to complete the admissions process as early as possible to be admitted before the December 1st deadline to be considered for a scholarship award. Arkansas State University awards scholarships to eligible students based on the funding available at the time of the award. A-State reserves the right to make changes to the scholarship program at any time based on the funds available, the number of eligible students and date students were admitted.

*Scholarship award letters will be mailed the third week of December.

A scholarship award will only be made to those students who have applied and been admitted to Arkansas State University. For a student to be considered for admission, we must receive an admission application, along with an official six–semester high school transcript, \$15 application fee and official ACT score. Please visit AState.edu/Admissions for complete admission details.

A-State Scholar, Excellence, Leadership and Pride Awards include an allowance for housing valued at a maximum of \$3720 for the year. Recipients not living on campus will have their award reduced by \$3720. All housing scholarships are contingent upon the availability of on-campus housing.
