



Spring break is almost here! Here are a few things you need to know about the upcoming break.

- *Residence halls will close on **Friday, March 17 at 5:00 PM**. ID cards will be turned off.*
- *The halls will reopen on Sunday, March 26 at noon.*
- *Front desk operations will take place in Northpark Quads Commons from 10am to 10pm on Monday-Friday and noon to 10pm on Saturday & Sunday.*
- *The cafeteria will be closed. Howl's Grill will be open for breakfast and lunch Monday, March 20 through Friday, March 24. Flex dollars **cannot** be used during this time period.*
- *You must pay the Spring Break housing fee if you plan to stay on campus during Spring Break. This must be paid in full at the time of request.*

If you wish to stay for Spring Break, you need to come by the Department of Residence Life (2053 Student Union) and pick up a Spring Break Payment form and pay the break fee at the Cashier's Window. You will then bring your receipt to the Residence Life office to receive your Spring Break pass. The break housing fee is \$85, if received on or by March 10. A late fee will be added to payments received after March 11. The costs with the late fees are listed below:

- *\$100 for payments received from March 13 – March 16*
- *\$125 for payments received on March 17*
- *\$150 for residents who have not paid the Spring Break fee and found in the halls after March 20*

*If you plan to be in the residence halls ANYTIME between 5:00pm, March 17 and noon, March 26, you will need to pay the full amount of \$85, even if you are only staying one night. **NOTE: Residents of Northpark Quads Bldgs 1 & 2, Greek Village, Collegiate Park, and Red Wolf Den do not have to pay the Spring Break Fees.***

Please note:** If you are caught in the residence halls without a break pass or proof of payment of break fees, your student account will be assessed a charge of \$150, and you will have a Student Conduct referral. **YOU MUST HAVE A SPRING BREAK PASS TO BE IN THE RESIDENCE HALLS DURING THE BREAK.
