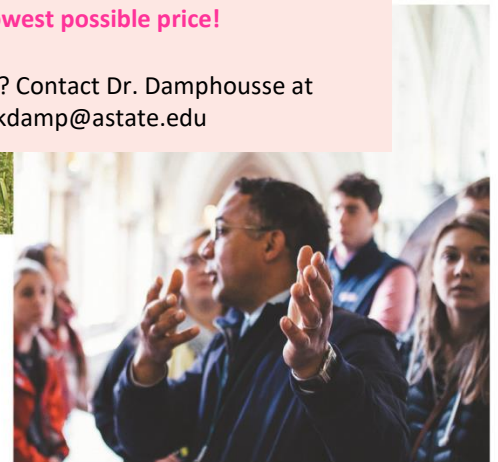

Travel beyond the major cities to explore the towering Cliffs of Moher, wander past ancient rock formations at Giant's Causeway, and stop at small towns along the Atlantic coast.
