### ■ MALPRACTICE INSURANCE

Before being assigned to clinical practicums, all students in College of Nursing and Health Professions programs are required to purchase malpractice/liability coverage.

# ■ CRIMINAL BACKGROUND CHECKS AND DRUG TESTING

Based on Arkansas legislation, students admitted to professional programs that require licensure in the state upon graduation are required to have a successful background check to complete formal admission. Information for obtaining the background check and drug test is provided by the program. Costs are borne by the students.

#### ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Even though students may declare a major in social work at any time in their academic career, students are required to submit a separate admissions application to the Department of Social Work at Arkansas State in order to be formally accepted into the program. Application for admission is due the second Friday in February. Entrance into the BSW program is a competitive process, and students must meet the following requirements for application consideration

- Must have completed a minimum of 45 hours at a college/university
- Have and maintain an overall cumulative GPA of 2.75 or higher to complete the BSW program
