

The Traveling Teachers Act of 2007

The purpose of the act is to assist school districts in providing appropriately licensed teachers to teach required courses in grades nine through twelve (9-12).

THE ACT:

AN ACT TO ESTABLISH THE ARKANSAS TRAVELING TEACHER PROGRAM TO ASSIST RURAL SCHOOL DISTRICTS IN PROVIDING APPROPRIATELY CERTIFIED LICENSED TEACHERS TO TEACH REQUIRED COURSES IN GRADES NINE THROUGH TWELVE (9-12); AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.
