Other Options for Honors Courses

If one of the above courses does not fit your schedule, you have other options. Please refer to the policies and procedures for each form **BEFORE** completing any applications. Honors Options are not listed on the schedule. For example, courses offered as HPESS, THEA, ART, and ACCT, are available as Honors Options for students who request them from their professors or departments. Each of the below listed course options



<u>requires you</u> to complete a hyperlinked form, which will direct you to INFOREADY. From there, you view the requirements to complete the application.

To allow time for processing and registration to align with the A-State Academic Calendar, the following are due no later than Monday, August 12, 2024. The application link and submission portal will close on that date.

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- <u>Honors Option:</u> The Honors-Option (H-O) procedure is designed to provide honors students the opportunity to obtain Honors credit in otherwise non-honors courses by providing special opportunities and experiences beyond those offered to the typical student.

- <u>Honors Independent Study:</u> Honors Independent Study is a course of study initiated by an honors student and carried out under the supervision of a member of the faculty with appropriate expertise. The student may propose work for either 3 or 6 hours of credit. https://astate.infoready4.com/#competitionDetail/1928974
 - NOTE: This option may be used as a preparatory course for the Honors senior thesis; however, if the course is used primarily for that purpose, a student may only count 3 credit hours of Honors Thesis credit toward the 24 credit hours to graduate "In University Honors."
- <u>Petition to Enroll in a Graduate Course for Undergraduate Honors Credit:</u> Students who are formally admitted to the Honors College may petition to enroll in a graduate course for undergraduate Honors credit.

- Honors Senior Thesis: The purpose of the Honors Senior Thesis is to provide a meaningful capstone project for an Arkansas State University senior's undergraduate education. The thesis will represent a significant effort beyond what is normally expected in a student's undergraduate program. The thesis should exemplify the goal of the Honors College experience as stated in the Undergraduate Bulletin, to "develop multiple intelligences, enhance their analytical skills, and augment their knowledge and abilities in their chosen fields." https://astate.infoready4.com/#competitionDetail/1928979



FOR ALL OF THE ABOVE FORMS: After your form is completed, it will go through an approval process through the respective parties (this is done automatically). Once all the respective individuals have approved your application, the Honors College will send you a CRN for this course, allowing you to register and to receive honors credit for the course.

HONORS ADVISING HOLD ERROR MESSAGE: When you register for an Honors course, you may receive an Honors Advising hold error message. The advising hold ensures that only Honors students can enroll in the course. The Honors Office can remove the hold with two pieces of information: your student ID number and the CRN for the course. You may call us at 870-972-2308, email us at honors@astate.edu, or come to the Honors College office in the Dean B. Ellis Library, Suite 103, and we will remove your hold.

HONORS PRIORITY REGISTRATION:

The Honors College no longer publishes an Honors Priority Registration List. Students who are enrolled in Honors courses have Priority Registration. Honors students who are on probation, are still eligible for Honors Priority Registration. If you have not requested to Opt Out of Honors or received written notice of your dismissal from Honors, then you are still eligible for Honors Priority Registration.

Students who are dismissed from Honors or who Opt Out of Honors, are not eligible for Honors Priority Registration.
