

SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA FOR INCOMING FRESHMEN

- Incoming Freshman must have an ACT of at least 24 to apply.
- Students must provide a complete application form, all unofficial transcripts, a digital portfolio of 5 works, and 2 recommendation letters before the application deadline. No late or incomplete applications will be considered. **2019 Deadline: Mon, Mar 11th, 11:59pm.**
- All scholarships are awarded on a yearly basis. If the criteria are not met each semester, the award is forfeited.
- This scholarship will be applied beginning the fall semester following this spring competition. Applicants must reapply in the following spring semester using the Current Student (vs. Incoming Freshman) application for the next school year.
- The recipient must be enrolled during the spring semester as a full-time student, with a minimum of 6 credit hours of GRFX, ART, ARED, ARTH and/or TIAR, or scholarship will be forfeited.
- The recipient will major in either a (1) BA in art with an emphasis in Art History; (2) BFA in Graphic Design; (3) BFA in Graphic Design with Digital Design emphasis; (4) BFA in Art with a studio art emphasis; or (5) BFA in Art with an emphasis in Art Education. If a scholarship recipient's major is changed to a degree outside of the Dept. of Art + Design, he/she forfeits the scholarship.
- · Scholarships will be distributed based on merit, not discipline.
- Scholarship amounts and availabilities may change from year to year.
