Award Requirements:

- Gold Scholarship: \$5,000 (\$2,500 / semester)
- Must be enrolled in at least 2 choral ensembles for 1 or 0 credits
- Participate in at least 3 recruitment-related events per semester as determined by the Director of Choral Activities.
- Student must make satisfactory progress in vocal study as determined by voice instructor

Silver Scholarship: \$3,000 (\$1,500 / semester)

- Must be enrolled in at least 2 choral ensembles for 1 or 0 credits
- Music majors must make satisfactory progress in vocal study as determined by voice instructor
- Non-music majors must also enroll in voice lessons and earn a 'B' or higher

Bronze Scholarship: \$2,000 (\$1,000 / semester)

- Must be enrolled in at least 1 choral ensemble for 1 or 0 credits
- Music majors must make satisfactory progress in vocal study as determined by voice instructor
- Voice lessons encouraged for non-majors

Choral Grant: \$1,200 (\$600 / semester)

- Must be enrolled in at least 1 choral ensemble for 1 or 0 credits
- Music majors must make satisfactory progress in vocal study as determined by voice instructor
- Voice lessons encouraged for non-majors
- * The Director of Choral Activities (DCA) will assign the student to each ensemble that is required to fulfill their scholarship. If a student chooses to enroll in ensembles beyond those required, they may elect where approved by the DCA.
- * All scholarship/grant recipients must maintain a 2.5 cumulative GPA and earn an 'A' in their ensemble in order to renew for the following semester.
- * Choral scholarships/grants are renewable for up to 10 semesters pending satisfactory audition each school year.
- * This scholarship is subject to review each semester. Failure to meet requirements results in a loss of award. Any changes to the listed requirements as well as ensemble placements must be approved by the Director of Choral Activities.
- * Must be enrolled in 15 credit hours at A-State.
