- ii. Shawn Drake explained that the Policy Group was going to look at further information regarding the dissertation committees and bring that information and recommendation back to the Graduate Council for further discussion. It won't go through Shared Governance until it is approved by Graduate Council.
- iii. Rokib Hasan explained to the Council that the Graduate Student Council has many concerns regarding graduate policies and the reinstatement of the Graduate School. Karen Wheeler advised him to reach out to her to speak to the GSC regarding this.
- iv. The Council agreed that it was important to be informed about the Graduate School, but also important not to sit on these issues.
- b. Amanda Wheeler asked about tabled documents and how they will get back on the agenda. Council asked to have an "Old Business" section on the agendas going forward.

Amanda Wheeler made a motion to adjourn. Seconded by John Mello. Meeting adjourned at 3:51 pm.
