The Department of Music had not previously held unified Audition Days representing the entire department. As the chair of the recruitment and audition committee, I (along with the committee members) facilitate and manage two department-wide audition days per university calendar. A-State Brass Fest (2022-present)

The A-State University Department of Music brass studios combined to host a festival for all brass musicians from our region this year. We welcomed students, amateurs, and professionals of all ages and all levels. Together with guest artists and vendors, we helped to provide resources and encourage growth for all of our brass musicians at A-State and throughout our community. I organized the itinerary and marketing.

Two colleagues and myself hosted a small summer program for Junior and Senior High students. The focus of the event was to encourage the exploration of chamber music among the local students by providing the opportunity for them to have lessons and perform in a chamber music setting. Students spent the day rehearsing in small chamber groups before culminating with a chamber music performance for family and friends. I arranged the music and conducted/rehearsed the combined group on the concert.

• Junior High All-Region Horn Clinic (2020)

During virtual learning, many students were struggling to find adequate instruction for their All-Region preparation, so the A-State Horn Studio hosted a Zoom clinic for the Junior High horn students in the region. The instruction and event promotion/organization was guided by me but executed by my students. One Facebook review stated: "Thanks for this clinic! [My daughter] ended up as Region 6 JH 1st band, 5th chair! It was wonderful hearing the horn ensemble play as well! Have a great year!"
