University Academic Integrity Committee (UAIC)

The University Academic Integrity Committee (UAIC) is a shared governance committee that considers cases of students accused of academic misconduct and determines whether the student is responsible. The UAIC does not determine sanctions.

The UAIC will consist of three faculty members, two undergraduates, and one graduate student from each academic college that has a graduate program. The Associate Vice Chancellor for Academic Services and the Graduate Dean will serve as Ex Officio members.

The convening committee for an academic misconduct hearing is three faculty members and one student. For cases involving academic misconduct of a graduate student, the student representative will be a graduate student.

The Committee reports to the Provost and Vice Chancellor for Academic Affairs and Research.
