

ITTC SMARTGuide for Progressive users to Blackboard Learn

This user guide focuses on creating a Discussion Board. Discussion Boards are created for students to interact with each other and discuss a particular topic. The following detailed steps will provide a complete tutorial on how to create a Discussion Board, Individual and Group Discussion threads.

1. Open your Course's Content Area by clicking on it.



2. You will see your content area. To add a Discussion Board, hover your mouse over the the Add Interactive Tool option. You will see a menu with Discussion Board on it. Click on it.



3. Now you will have two options. First one is to **Create Forum** and second one is to use an already created discussion board by adding a link to it. To continue creating a new one click on **Create New Forum** button.





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5. You will see a Forum information page. Enter a name for the forum as well as any additional text information you would like to enter in the box. Some other options on the same page would be about **Forum Availability** and **Forum Settings**.

Note: A forum will not be available to students until it is made available to them through the Forum Availability setting.

6. Read the **Forum Settings** carefully and check/uncheck the appropriate settings according to your choice.

7. Click on **Submit** Button.

8. Create Link You will see a Create Link: Discussion Board page like the one given below. As you can see below you will have two options to proceed. Select Link to the Discussion Board Page or Select a Discussion Board Forum.

1. Click on **Discussions** under the course menu .



2. You will now see a Discussion Board page with all the forums you have created listed on it. Click on the Chevron next to the forum name which you want to edit. You will see a menu with an edit option. Click on it and make the required changes.

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How to Reply to a Thread Entry

- 1. Click the name of the forum in the Discussion Board.
- 2. You will see a list of **threads**.



3. Click the **name of the thread**. You will see the details about the thread and any text from the author of that thread.

4. Click on **Reply** button below the message to which you want to reply. Enter the **subject** for your reply as well as any additional text you want to enter. You can also upload a file from your computer by clicking on **Browse my Computer** to attach any files along with your reply. In the end click on **Submit** button. You will see threads as well as the replies to that thread on the forum page as given below.
