

## Request for the Selection of a MS (Thesis) Advisory Committee Graduate Program in Environmental Sciences

The Graduate School accepts recommendations from the student's advisor for committee members. The program director has the responsibility of assigning the advisor. This action is to be taken in the student's first year of study within the program.

1. Master's committees must have a minimum of four members.
2. Each committee shall have at least one member from both the natural and social sciences.
3. One member may be from outside the University (adjunct graduate faculty status is required)
4. Master's committee membership will be reviewed by the EVS Graduate Program Committee and the Associate Dean of the College of Sciences and Mathematics and is subject to the approval of the Dean of the Graduate School.
