

ITTC SMARTGuide for Progressive users to Blackboard Learn

This user guide focuses on creating a test & editing a test in blackboard for new users to blackboard learn. A test is an assessment tool which can be created, deployed and then graded. The following detailed steps will provide a complete tutorial for creating a test and editing it. After creating a test you can go through the **Deploying Tests** guide.

Creating Tests

1. Expand the **Control Panel** under **Course** Management on the left hand side of the screen by clicking on it.

2. Now Expand the Course Tools section under it.

3. Now click on Tests, Surveys, and Pools.

4. Click on Tests now.



5. You will see a **Build Test** option. Click on it.



6. Enter the name, description, and instructions. Click on Submit button.



7. Before Creating the Questions you can change the Question Settings.





As you can see from the screenshot below that any setting can be checked or unchecked from the corresponding check boxes for each option. When you are done click on **Submit** button.

8. Now hover the mouse on **Create Question** and select **question** type you want to create by clicking on it.Some question types are listed below for information.

Question Type				
True/False	Students select the validity of a statement			
Multiple Choice	Students select the single correct answer from a series of answers			
Multiple Answer	Students select one or more correct answers from a series of answers			
Ordering	Students are presented with a list of items they must place in order according to criteria specified in the question			
Matching	Students are presented with two lists of items and must pair items from one list with the other list			
Fill-in-the-Blank	Students enter text or numbers to complete a statement			
Essay	Students write a detailed response to a question or statement			

9. Fill out the necessary information for each question type you create. And always remember, after each setting you change, anything you add you have to click on **Submit** button.



Editing Tests

1. On Tests, Pools, and Surveys select Tests. You will see the list of tests that you have created.

2. When you click on action button you will an option to Edit, Export, Copy, Delete a test.

3. Click on **Edit**. The list of questions you created will be displayed. If you want to change the question content click on chevron button corresponding to any question you want to **Edit**.

4. To modify or add points, check the checkbox before each question. Add the points into the points box, click **Update**. When you are done Click on the **OK button** on the bottom right corner.
