- 1. Go to the Internal Revenue Service website at <u>www.irs.gov</u>
- 2. Type "14039" in the search box. Down load, complete the form, and submit it to the IRS
- 3. Go to one of the three (3) credit reporting agencies, <u>www.equifax.com</u>; <u>www.experian.com</u>; or <u>www.transunion.com</u>; and place a fraud alert on your file
- 4. Go to <u>www.annualcreditreport.com</u> and download a free copy of your credit report to verify that your identify has not been stolen
