- Determinate varieties
(grows to specific ht and fruits
at same time)
- 15" tall, 30" + wide
- 9 oz fruit

Tomato – Supersweet 100



- Indeterminate
- 1" fruit
- Sweet fruit with high Vitamin C content
- Vining plant

Asclepias –Orange and yellow/red Butterflyweed



- Annual (yellow/red)
- Perennial (orange)
- 3'tall
- Monarch Larva love them

Begonia – Cocktail mix



- Annual
- 8-12"
- Red, pink and white flowers
- Partial shade or full sun



Butterfly Bush



- Perennial
- Full sun
- lavender flowers
- 4'-6' tall
- **Butterflies love!!**
- Prune to 6" tall each year

Coleus – Full Sun!!



'Red Ruffles'

- Full Sun
- 'Tiger lily', 'Grey Ghost', 'Red Ruffle', 'Grape expectations'
- Annual
- Grows 24"+ tall and wide

Coleus – Wizard mix (Shade)



- Shade
- Annual
- Multi-colored foliage
- 12' tall
 - (pinch off flowers)

Geranium



- Red
- 5-6" red flower heads
- Partial shade (morning sun)
- 12" tall plants

White, red, blue (light

Citronella, Scented Geranium



- Full sun
- Annual
- 15-18" tall and wide
- Fragrant foliage

Lantana



Lantana camara 'Irene'



- Full sun
- Ht 6"-24"
- Tough plant
- Will tolerate drought when established
- Many colors
- Butterflies love!!

- Annual (semi-perennial)
- Full sun
- Purple or white flowers
- 8"-12" tall (12-18" wide)

Nicotiana – flowering tobacco



- Full sun
- Annual
- 8"-12" tall, 8" wide
- Good for hot, dry sites
- Flowers all summer

Petunia – Dreams White



- 2-3 inch blooms
- Ht 10-14"
- Full to part sun



Petunia - Wave



- Full sun
- flowers, 2-3"
- Ht 6", spread 3'
- Red flowers



Phlox - Pomegranate



- Flowers 1-1.5" wide
- Fragrant
- Plants 14-20" tall, 12" wide
- Blooms all summer

Portulaca – Moss Rose



- Full sun
- 4" tall, 12" wide
- 2" flowers, mixed colors
- Loves hot and dry sites

Porterweed



- Full sun
- Annual
- Purples, pinks
- Tall (3-4+') and
– Dwarfs (1-2')
- **Butterflies love!!**

Salvia leucantha – Mealy Sage

Fall blooming salvia



- Annual or semi-annual
- Full sun
- 3' tall
- Purple or purple/white flowers in fall



- **Butterflies love!!**

Salvia



- Annual
- Full sun
- 12-14" tall
- Summer Flowers
- **Hummingbirds and butterflies love it**

Ornamental Pepper – Chilly Chilli



- Full sun
- Very heat tolerant
- Ht 12" - spread 6-10"
- Mild 2" peppers change from yellow to orange to red

Zinnia



- Z. angustifolia
- Z. 'Big Red'
- Z. 'Dreamland' hybrids
- Z. 'Profusion' hybrids

- Full sun, annual
- **Butterflies love!!**

Cuphea - Matchmaker Scarlet



- Annual
- Butterflies love
- Orange purple flowers
- Flowers all summer
- Full sun

Purple Fountain Grass



- Full sun
- Purple leaves
- Purple flower plumes
- 3-5' tall
- Annual

Sweet Potato Vines



- 'Chartreuse' = green
- 'Blackie' = dk purple
- 'Tricolor' = green/pur/white
- 'Sweet Caroline Green/Yellow'
- 'Caroline purple'

- Grows to at least 5'x5' area
- Full sun

Torenia – Kauai Magenta



- Annual
- Sun / part-shade
- Heat/humidity tolerant
- 16" x 16" plant size

- Ivy Geraniums
- Boston Ferns
- Purple/Purple Wandering Jew

- Bolivian Jew
- Pothos
- Spider plants
- Swedish Ivy
- Bridal wreath



Perennials

Coreopsis – Route 66



- Full sun
- Blooms are 2" wide
- Attracts butterflies
- Changes color throughout season

Echinacea - Magnus



- Rosy purple flowers
- Full sun to part shade
- Blooms June-August
- **Attracts butterflies!**



Geum – Mrs. Bradshaw



- 1-2 ft. tall
- Blooms May & June
- Orange/scarlett flowers
- Sun, afternoon shade



Phlox – Peacock Cherry



- Perennial
- Sun /Part-Sun
- Blooms June – Sept.
- Compact, Bushy
- Abundant Flowers

Penstemon Arabesque – Apple Blossom



- Full Sun
- Plants 20-24" wide
- Good for cut flowers
- Attract Butterflies & hummingbirds
- Large trumpet-shaped, pale pink/white blooms

Herbs

- Tarragon
- Fernleaf Dill
- Cilantro
- Parsley

Orchids

Hybrid Cattleya Orchid Seedlings



Kim's white— Small plant, blooms 2-3 times per season, flowers held in cascade

These seedlings are a result of crosses between these two parents and produced via Tissue Culture. Seedlings are either hybrid 1.- Kim (mom) x Candice (dad) or hybrid 2. Candice (mom) x Kim (dad).

We hope you'll be successful blooming them, and you should anticipate that the progeny will have colors, heights, and fragrance somewhere between the two parents.

Candice— Tall plant, very fragrant, blooms once usually in September.
