ONLINE courses are RESTRICTED to students taking EXCLUSIVELY ONLINE PROGRAMS. PERMITS MUST BE ISSUED BY THE DEPARTMENT IN ORDER TO REGISTER. Online sections are offered for Elementary I, Elementary II, Intermediate I, and Intermediate II. The two unit exams and the final exam for these courses must be taken in a supervised environment. Students have the option of taking exams on the university campus or through a proctor at an established business or educational facility in their area. If you have previous language experience, please take a free online placement test at this URL: <http://webcape.byuhtrsc.org> On the prompt, select Arkansas State University and press GO. Next, enter the password: RedWolves (case sensitive!). Select the language you wish to be tested in. Then follow the instructions provided. Follow up with the Department of World Languages and Cultures after receiving your score by bringing a copy of the results page to Wilson room 220, or emailing it to languages@astate.edu. We will gladly help you with the appropriate placement and provide the associated enrollment permits.
