Keynote Speaker: Barbara Ross-Lee, D.O., FACOFP is the Vice President for Health Sciences and Medical Affairs at the NYIT College of Osteopathic Medicine. Dr. Ross-Lee is a nationally-recognized expert on health policy issues and serves as an advisor for state and federal governments on primary care, medical education, and health care issues affecting minorities, women, and rural populations. A sought-after lecturer, Ross-Lee has published numerous scholarly articles on a variety of medical and health care issues. She is the recipient of six honorary degrees and many national awards.

Arkansas State University Social Work Department seeks dynamic presentations of health disparities, well initiatives, and innovative prevention strategies for communities at risk in the Delta region. Workshop sessions will be simultaneous and one to two hours in length. Each workshop proposal should incorporate best practice information, and encourage group interaction and discussion.

Presentations should focus on issues that affect health disparities in the Delta such as race, income, obesity, nutrition, economics, and HIV. The conference registration fee is ten dollars for students and fifty dollars for others. Participants can earn Continuing Education Contact hours.

- a. Statement of the problem, including documented empirical evidence
- b. Study objectives, research questions or hypotheses

2. Methods

- a. Research design
- b. Sampling and data collection
- c. Measurement and instrumentation

3. Results and Conclusions

- a. Specific outcomes and key finding
- b. Implication for social work practice and policy regarding healthcare in the Delta Region.
- c. Future Research and direction
