This information will be made available to the potential scholars. All current full-time A-State faculty/staff and affiliated faculty/staff that have an area of expertise/research that adheres to the ABI Mission Statement are eligible.

Mentor's Benefits and Responsibilities

- Mentors will receive a \$1,250 stipend to purchase supplies to support research/project/creative work of their student.
- Mentors agree to supervise and assist the scholar with the project, encourage involvement (as appropriate) the scholar in possible publications, attend the Annual Fall ABI Research Symposium (if possible), participate in Create@State, participate in podcasts, and guide the scholar in preparation of their presentation from their research findings.
