

A-State Hybrid Transfer Scholarship Guidelines (2022-23)

The A-State Hybrid Transfer Scholarship is administered through the A-State Financial Aid & Scholarships Office. Any questions concerning the scholarship should be directed to the Financial Aid & Scholarship Office at (870) 972-2310.

Arkansas State University reserves the right to make changes to the scholarship program at any time based on available funding and eligible applicants.

What the Scholarship Covers:

- * The A-State Hybrid Transfer Scholarship provides up to \$2000 per semester toward tuition and fees.
- * Award is only for the A-State campus.
- * Awards are contingent upon the availability of funds.
- * This scholarship is awarded for the duration of four consecutive semesters, or through completion of the undergraduate degree, or until all courses for degree are completed, whichever occurs first; provided the student maintains all scholarship requirements.
- *Students must be seeking their first Bachelor's Degree.

How to Qualify:

- * Must be a U.S. citizen who is transferring from a two or four-year accredited college.
- * Must have 24 transferrable hours (as determined by A-State Admissions Office) from accredited college with a cumulative 3.25 GPA.
- * Must be accepted into a Hybrid Degree program.
- * Concurrent, AP, CLEP, Military, PLA and Remediation hours are excluded from the required 24 hours.
- * Residents and non-residents of Arkansas are eligible to apply.
- * Current A-State students are ineligible to apply.
- * Students must be fully admitted by July 15 for fall enrollment and fully admitted by December 15 for spring enrollment.
- * Cannot be combined with any other A-State Institutional Scholarship.
- * Students with only concurrent transfer work while in high school are ineligible.
- * No scholarship application is required and scholarship awards are mailed to eligible candidates after the student is fully admitted and eligibility is determined.
- * A limited number of awards are available
- * The deadline for acceptance is 30 days from the date of the scholarship offer.

Students Responsibilities for Accepting and Maintaining the A-State Hybrid Transfer Scholarship:

To accept the 2022-23 scholarship offer:

- 1. Login at My. AState.edu
 - Click the First Time Users button and follow the prompts, if applicable.
- 2. Select Banner Self Service button
- 3. Select the **Financial Aid link** and choose **Award Year 2022-23**
- 4. Follow the links in the **Scholarships Section** to complete the following:
 - *Accept/Decline your A-State Scholarship Offer
 - *Accept the Terms and Conditions of your A-State Scholarship Offer (If accepting scholarship)
- * Students who are selected to receive the A-State Hybrid Transfer Scholarship will have 30 days to accept the scholarship offer. After that time, the scholarship offer will no longer be valid. Should you accept the scholarship and later decide to attend another university, please notify the Financial Aid & Scholarships Office in writing by email at Scholarships@astate.edu or postal mail.
- * Enrollment of a minimum 15 credit hours toward a Bachelor's Degree at the A-State campus is required during each consecutive Fall and Spring semester. Concurrent enrollment on another campus **cannot** be used to meet full-time enrollment status nor be paid for by the scholarship. Enrollment is locked at midnight on the 11th class day. Students in an academic program that is lock-stepped and prohibits 15 hours in any given semester will be allowed to receive their scholarship upon approval of Scholarship Office and receipt of letter from academic advisor. Students in their final semester of scholarship eligibility or final semester and graduating will be allowed to take a minimum of 12 hours upon notifying the Scholarship Office by email at Scholarship@astate.edu. Please notify the Scholarship Office if you are graduating early.
- * All students must enroll in courses from the A-State Hybrid Program in the semester of the award.
- * Award holders who are dependents of faculty and staff will be paid 25 percent of the scholarship value per semester for credit hours at the A-State campus in addition to the faculty/staff discount.
- * Silver Scholars are ineligible for this award.
- * If at any time the recipient becomes ineligible for federal financial aid, the student forfeits their scholarship for that semester and all future semesters.
- * All college-level course work is calculated into the overall GPA for scholarship renewal.
- * Students are required to maintain an overall 3.250 GPA and successfully complete 15 credit hours each academic semester at the A-State campus. Note- accepted transfer credits will be calculated into overall GPA.
- * Any student who receives all Ws, Fs, WNs, Is and/or FNs at the end of their semester will lose their scholarship for all subsequent semesters. If you have any grade changes you are responsible for contacting the Scholarship Office to request your scholarship status be reevaluated.
- * For military exceptions, contact the Scholarships Office at (870) 972-2310.
- *Students who have lost their scholarship eligibility have the opportunity to regain eligibility if the student meets the criteria at the end of the following fall or spring semester. Students have to complete 15 A-State hours and have an overall 3.250 GPA at the end of the next academic year after losing the scholarship. All course work must be at the A-State campus. Students meeting this requirement simply need to email their scholarship reinstatement request to Scholarships@AState.edu at the end of the semester after regaining eligibility. Students will be notified by email after eligibility has been verified.
