2020-2021 INSTITUTIONAL SCHOLARSHIPS

The Financial Aid & Scholarships Office uses a holistic process to award a limited number of freshman scholarships to top applicants who are admitted to the university and have completed the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) by December 1st for priority consideration. These applicants are chosen based on merit, community involvement, leadership qualities, extracurricular activities, etc.

- > Students must be admitted by December 1st to receive full consideration for an A-State Institutional Scholarship. A-State awards scholarships to top applicants based on the funding available at the time of the award. A-State reserves the right to make changes to the scholarship program at any time based on the funds available, the number of eligible students and date students were admitted.
- > Priority Scholarship letters will be mailed the third week of December. Any additional offers will be mailed the first week of each following month through June 1, 2020 based on available funds.
- > All scholarships are administered according to University guidelines *AState.edu/Scholarships*
- > A scholarship award will only be made to those students who have applied and been admitted to Arkansas State University. For a student to be considered for admission, we must receive an admission application, along with an official six semester high school transcript, \$30 application fee, and official ACT or SAT score. Please visit *AState.edu/Admissions* for complete admission details.
- > All A-State Scholar housing scholarships are contingent upon the availability of on-campus housing.
