# **2022 Greek Week Schedule of Events:**

### Tuesday, April 5th – Kickball Tournament & Obstacle Course Relay

When: 4pm-8:30pm

Where: A-State Intramural Fields

**What:** Teams will compete in a five-team bracket Kickball Tournament. No entry fee. Teams will also compete in an Inflatable Obstacle Course Relay Race. Food and music will be available! Teams must sign up via the corresponding links below for both Kickball and the Obstacle Course.

#### <u>Sign-Up Here</u> for Kickball Tournament

#### • Kickball Tournament Rules:

1. KICKBALL TOURNAMENT IS SINGLE ELIMINATION format.

2. Games are (4) innings or 45 minutes, whichever

comes first.

3. Each half-inning consists of (3) outs.

4. A total of (3) strikes equals (1) out.

5. Kicking the ball foul (4) times in one at-bat will be considered an out.

6. Stealing bases is prohibited and will be considered an out.

7. Leaving the base before the ball is kicked will

result in the runner being called out.

8. Players must tag up if a fly ball is caught before

proceeding to advance bases.

9. No headshots.

- Runners hit in the head with the ball will be safe with the exception of sliding into a base.

10. Limited to 12 players per team, and must be male, female

- 10 players on the field at one time

#### <u>Sign-Up Here</u> for Obstacle Course Relay

#### • Obstacle Course:

- Teams may register one group of 10 participants.
- Each team MUST consist of at least 4 males and 4 females. There must be at least one representative from each organization.

- All participants will enter, complete, and exit the course INDIVIDUALLY. The line-up will be female, male, female, male, and so on.
- Seeding will be determined by a mini game/challenge before the event. Team Captains will compete for seeding on behalf of their Greek Week Team. The challenge will be announced and explained at the Captain's Meeting.
- The Winner of each Obstacle Course round will advance to the next round.
- If any team member takes what is deemed a "shortcut" on the obstacle course, he/she will be made to re-enter and complete their turn over.

**Points Awarded:** Attendance, Diversity, and Competition points for the Kickball Tournament. Competition and Diversity points for the Obstacle Course Relay.

### Thursday, April 7th – NBA Greek V. Basketball Tournament

**When:** Captain's Meeting- 4:30 pm; First Game- 5:00 pm; Championship-7:30 pm **Where:** Red Wolf Center Basketball Courts - Court A

**What:** Teams will compete in male and female division entry fee amount (\$100 per Greek Week Team- all chapters on a team may contribute toward this entry fee. If a team experiences difficulty covering this fee, please notify the Office of FSL). Music by DJ King Vick.

#### Sign-Up Here

- Minimum 5 players and Maximum 12 players per team
- Sign Up your two teams via Google Doc: (Google Doc will be emailed)
- Expected Tournament Structure:
  - *Men's Bracket* Maximum 5 team, single elimination, 12 minute, running halves (16 minutes running halves for championship games).
  - *Women's Bracket* Maximum 5 team, single elimination, 12 minute, running halves (16 minutes running halves for championship games).
- Captains' Meeting will be at 3:30pm in the Red Wolf Center on Court 1. Please designate two Captains for your Greek Week Basketball Team- 1 for your Greek Week Team men's basketball team and 1 for your Greek Week Team women's basketball team.
  - Seeding will be determined by a simple game of knockout played by team captains.

### Thursday, April 7th – Volleyball Tournament

**When:** Captain's Meeting- 4:30 pm; First Game- 5:00 pm; Championship-7:30 pm **Where:** Red Wolf Center Basketball Courts- Court S

**What:** Teams will compete in male and female division entry fee amount (\$100 per Greek Week Team- all chapters on a team may contribute toward this entry fee. If a team experiences difficulty covering this fee, please notify the Office of FSL). Music by DJ King Vick.

#### Sign-Up Here

- Each match will consist of the best 2 out of 3 games. The first team scoring twenty one (21) points (win by 2 or a 25-point cap) will be declared the winner. If a third game of the match is necessary, rally scoring to fifteen (15) points (do not have to win by 2) will determine the winner. Rally scoring will be used for all games.
- Game time is forfeit time. If a team has the minimum number of players to begin a game (5 for 6v6) & their opponent does not AT GAME TIME the game shall be forfeited.
- A rock/paper/scissor contest at the beginning of the match will determine which team receives the choice of first serve or choice of side of the court for the first game. The loser receives the remaining option. In the event of a third game of the match, a second contest will determine the choice of the first serve or side.
- The teams shall change sides of the court for the second game. Teams shall not change sides of the court in the middle of the third game.
- Timeouts: Teams have one (1) timeout per game. Clock will stop for ALL timeouts.

**Points Awarded:** Attendance, Diversity, and Competition points for Volleyball games (Attendance points will be awarded once for this night of events. The total number of Greek Week Team Members you have in attendance in the Red Wolf Center will determine total Attendance Points awarded).

# Friday, April 8th- A-State Day at the Park Baseball Game, Tailgate & A-State Food Pantry Donations Drive

#### When: Tailgating- 5pm | First Pitch- 6pm

Where: Tomlinson Stadium-Kell Field

**What:** Tailgate with your team at the baseball game! There will be food, live music, and give-aways! SAB is hosting a Day at the Park competition that is separate from Greek Week. SAB's competition is for all student organizations in attendance at Day at the Park. There will be a Greek Division, RSO Division, and Res Hall Division. This SAB competition has two parts: Food Donations Drive & Day at the Park Attendance. See below for a breakdown:

- Attendance- Scan-In at the designated SAB Table so attendance points can be calculated for SAB's competition. SAB will be awarding 1 point per student for their attendance competition. This attendance will then be used to calculate Greek Week Attendance Points using the standard Greek Week Attendance Points Rubric at the end of this document.
- 2. Food Donations Drive SAB will be awarding 1 point per donated food item from the list below. Greek Week Competition Points will then be awarded as 1st-5th based on the number of each Greek Week Team's donated items. Any Greek Week Team that participates in the Donations Drive will receive 25 participation points, as stated in the Competition Points Rubric at the end of this document. Teams may drop off donated items at any of the below days/times.

#### **Points Awarded:**

- Attendance points: points awarded for members of each Greek Week' Team in attendance for the game. Attendance will be documented by each team having a QR Code to scan using the A-State Student App at the SAB Table.
- Competition Points: Points awarded for the A-State Food Pantry Donations Drive.

# **Information and Rules Packet:**

#### **Expectations:**

- Maintain positive all-Greek attitude
- No alcohol is allowed at ANY Greek Week Event
  - Day at the Park: Alcohol may be responsibly and legally purchased and consumed only if purchased from concessions at Tomlinson Stadium. Due to the spirit of Greek Week, coolers with alcohol and/or other sources of alcohol are strictly prohibited.
- No harassment or profanity
- Maintain good sportsmanship and obey the rules

Attendance: (If a chapter on your Greek Week Team is unable to compete and/or attend in a particular event(s), communicate with the Office of Fraternity & Sorority Life to request a waiver for that competition's Attendance Points. If the Office of FSL approves the Greek Week Team's request, attendance points will be adjusted and awarded accordingly. All chapters are expected to support as fully as possible. Approval will only be given for what is deemed as unavoidable and extenuating circumstances).

- Fewer than 40% of the team = 20 points
- 40%-59% of the team = 40 points
- 60%-84% or more of the team = 60 points
- 85%-89% or more of the team = 80 points
- 90%-100% of the team = 100 points

\*\*Attendance points for each team will be calculated using the totals for each team based on chapter rosters. Attendees for each team will scan in on their corresponding team's QR code (A-State Student App). <u>Chapters are expected to ensure their Google Doc Chapter Rosters are updated prior to Greek Week beginning.</u>

**Diversity:** (If a chapter on your Greek Week Team is unable to compete in a particular event(s), communicate with the Office of Fraternity & Sorority Life to request a waiver for that competition's Diversity Points. If the Office of FSL

approves the Greek Week Team's request, diversity points will be adjusted and awarded accordingly. All chapters are expected to support as fully as possible. Approval will only be given for what is deemed as unavoidable and extenuating circumstances). See Below for breakdown of points possible.

If you have 4 orgs on your Greek Week Team:

- Representation from only 1 chapters = 5 points
- · Representation from only 2 chapters = 20 points
- Representation from only 3 chapters = 50 points
- · Representation from all 4 chapters = 100 points

If you have 5 orgs on your Greek Week Team:

- Representation from only 1 chapters = 5 points
- Representation from only 2 chapters = 20 points
- Representation from only 3 chapters = 50 points
- Representation from only 4 chapters = 65 points
- Representation from all 5 chapters = 100 points

#### Competition (Kickball, Obstacle Course, NBA Greek Men's Basketball Tournament, & Women's Volleyball Tournament):

- 25 participation points, awarded to each Greek Week Team for simply showing up and competing
- 250 points- 1st Place
- 200 points- 2nd Place
- 150 points- 3rd Place
- 100 points- 4th Place
- 50 Points- 5th Place
