Q & A with Rachel

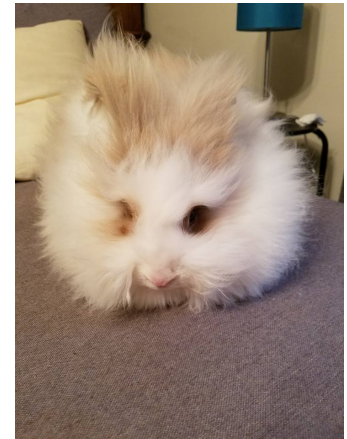
Do you have any hobbies?
