ACCESS & ACCOMMODATION SERVICES

Provide accommodations and support for students with disabilities

- Any student with a disability can receive services from our office
- Those with temporary impairments can also register with our office
- Documentation can consist of a 504 or IEP Plan from high school, Psychoeducational Evaluation, letter from a psychiatrist, psychologist, doctor, or other health care professional









HOW TO REGISTER

- Fill out the online application on the A&AS website (AIM Portal)
- Upload documentation during the application (or have it mailed, faxed, or emailed to dservices@astate.edu)
 - Do not let lack of documentation deter from applying for services
- Do an intake session with a counselor in our office
- PROCESS DONE (notification letters are sent out to professors each semester)










COMMON SERVICES OFFERED
