

Honors Council Reorganization Proposal

In response to the reorganization of colleges at Arkansas State University the Honors Council as a shared governance committee recommends restructuring the committee to more appropriately reflect the Honors student enrollment relative to each college while considering the workload of the Honors Council Representatives.
