

Short-Term Intensive Japanese Program January 10 — January 26, 2018 Niiza Campus, Rikkyo University

Program Capacity and Schedule



The Rikkyo Short-Term Intensive Japanese Program starts on Wednesday, Jan. 10 and ends on Friday, Jan. 26, 2018. The entire program comprises 45 hours of classroom instruction plus 25 hours of lectures on Japanese culture and society, including field trips. The program capacity is limited to 20 students. Upon completing the full 3-week program, participants will be given a certificate of completion and an official transcript. The program, including room and board, is conducted on the Niiza campus, and participants need to arrive and check in at the accommodation on Tuesday, Jan. 9, and check out on Saturday, Jan. 27, 2018.

Requirements The following students can apply for this program.

- 1. The students who are enrolled at Rikkyo University's partner universities.
- 2. The students at universities that are now negotiating with Rikkyo for a partner universities.
- 3. The students who were introduced to the program by the teaching staff of Rikkyo University.

Tuition and Fees

The cost of the Short-Term Intensive Japanese Program, including tuition, room, board (breakfast and dinner on weekdays) and the fees for all program activities, is approximately 300,000 yen. The program cost does not include transportation costs (to and within Japan), or any other miscellaneous living expenses for the duration of the program. Itemized List of Program Costs> *Room options are determined based on availability.

- Tuition: 150,000 yen Administrative Fee: 25,000 yen
- Room & board: (2-person shared) 95,400 yen, (4-person shared) 88,900 yen
- · Activity Fees (including Insurance Fee): 8,000 yen

Total: (2-person shared) 278,400 yen, (4-person shared) 271,900 yen

* A hotel near to Niiza Station will be arranged for Jan. 9th to Jan. 14th 2018. Breakfast is included, however dinner will not be provided on the evenings of Jan. 9th to 12th. You will need to arrange your own dinner on these evenings. After Jan. 14, you will stay at the University accommodation.

* Rikkyo University will join in the following insurance. Injury & sickness death 3 million Yen, injury physical impediment 3 million Yen, treatment of disease & physical illness rejection 3 million Yen, rescuer's expenses 3 million Yen, personal liability insurance compensation authorized 100 million Yen, which includes incidental settlement negotiation services. However it is each participant's own responsibility to arrange her/his own insurance policy to cover all necessary costs as our insurance does not cover chronic disease.

The program fee payment must be submitted between Oct. 27 and Nov. 3, 2017 through credit card payment.
