Mobility Program for A-State Staff member to University of Huelva (Spain)

DESCRIPTION OF MOBILITY BENEFITS:

- 1. Duration: 5 days + 2 days travel
- 2. Financial Assistance: 120 euros/working day including 2 days of travel + 820 euros for travel expenses. (Health insurance and accommodations not included).
- 3. Areas of Study: Education, Humanities, Languages, Business Administration, Law, Environment, Chemistry, Engineering and Engineering Trades, Agriculture, Forestry, Social Work, and Counselling.
- 4. Program Dates: September 2018 July 2019

STAFF FOR TRAINING:

Attending the UHU International Week events. Participate in the activities. Collaborate with small presentations about departmental projects or other key topics interesting for the ERASMUS community. September 2019 – July 2019

STAFF FOR TEACHING (ONLY FOR ACADEMIC STAFF MEMBERS):

Collaborate with teaching activities during one week in the host University (this mode must be discussed previously with UHU Academic coordinator). Dates: October 2018 –January 2019 or February 2019-May 2019





REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. Must be full-time staff
- 2. Applicants should submit the following:
- Submission of motivation letter explaining why you want to take part in the programme and which are your expectations (200-300 words).
- Submission of a short Biography including the List of Projects/ Topics which you would be willing to present on (Staff for training) or the courses you would be teaching (Staff for teaching).
- At least 2 tentative dates of travel: (departure and return)
- Accreditation of Spanish language proficiency (if available).

SELECTION PROCESS:

Education and work experience related to the mobility focus	40%
Value of proposed return activity (commitment with Erasmus Program)	40%
Level of Spanish competency (if available)	20%

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS FOR A-STATE:

- 1. Submission of a Letter of Interest addressing why you want to take part in this programme, your expectations, and what makes you a better candidate for the scholarship.
- 2. Submission of a short Biography including the List of Projects/ Topics which you would be willing to present (Staff for training) or the courses you would be interested in teaching (Staff for teaching).
- 3. Proof of Spanish competency

APPLICATION DEADLINE: SEPTEMBER 28TH, 2018

Interested Staff must submit a complete application on or before 5:00 pm on September 28th, 2018. Letters of Interest must be submitted inside a sealed envelope to the Study Abroad Office, International Programs Building, Room # N219.
