IRS regulations require the filing status "Married Filing Jointly" or "Married Filing Separately" for individuals who are married at the end of the 2023 tax year.
- ☐ They were married, but **separated** from one another for the last 6 months of 2023.
IRS regulations allow a person who is married to file as "Head of Household" if they were considered unmarried on the last day of the tax year, did not live in the same home as his/her spouse for at least the last 6 months of the tax year, paid more than 50% of the cost of keeping up the home for 2023, and had a "qualifying" person live in the house for more than half the year.
