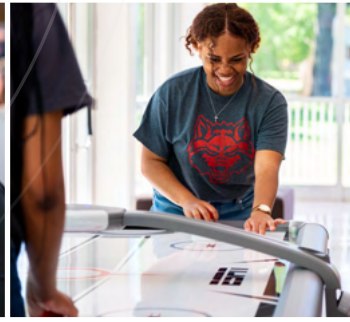

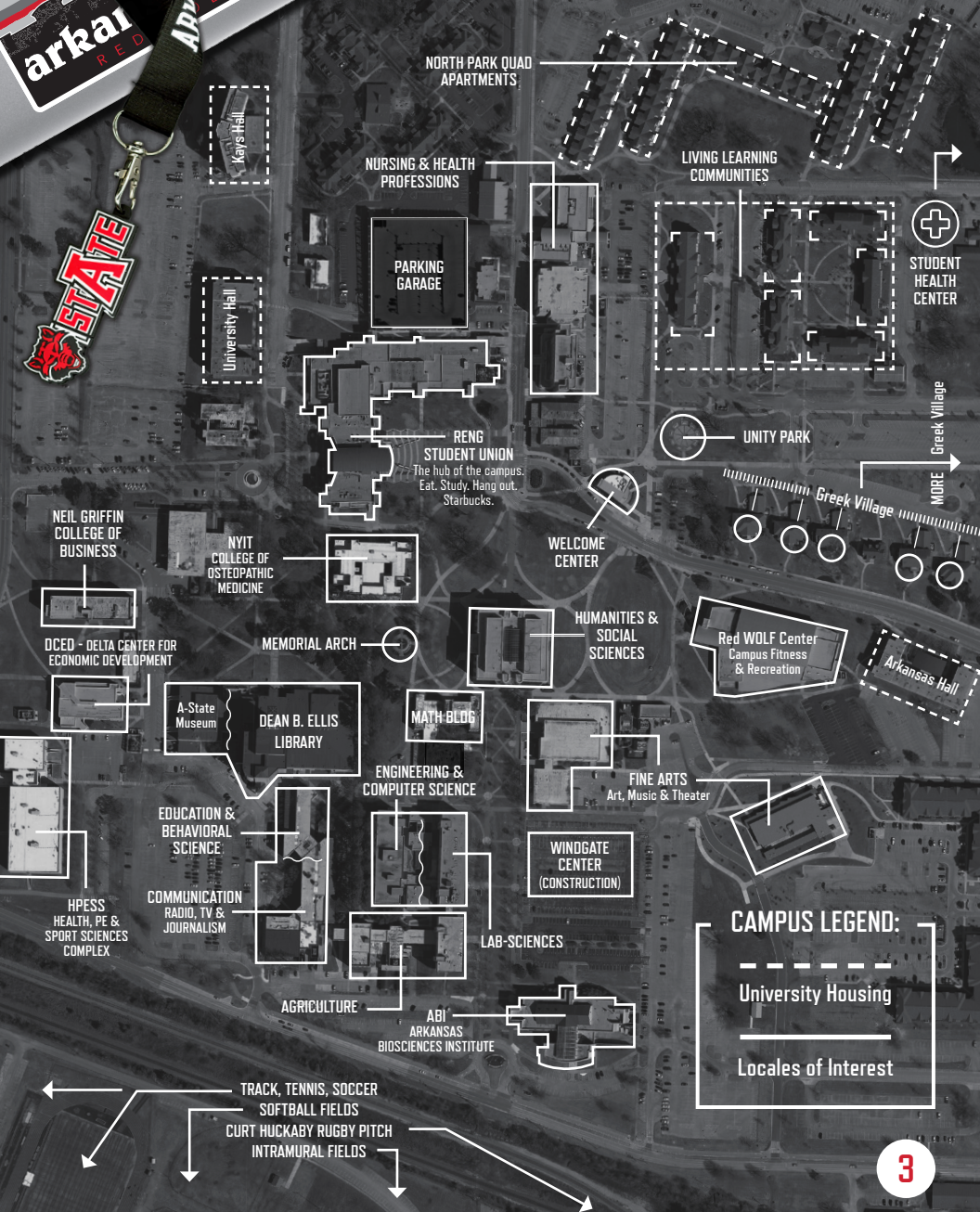

IT SECURITY: The mission of A-State's IT Security department is to educate and equip our users to better protect the university's digital environment. In order to do that, we have each user set up security questions as well as a two-factor authentication. Security questions help us to verify you in case you need phone support from our Help Desk and/or our security team. Duo Mobile is our two-factor security process to help ensure your personal information stays secure.



Our team also aims to educate and empower faculty, staff and students to make informed and smart security decisions based on information security policies, tools, and awareness training initiatives. We develop, maintain and test disaster recovery plans. Our team promotes an effective information security awareness and training program commensurate with the needs of the university.
