2022 Undergraduate Admission Packet Coordinated Program in Dietetics

Enrollment in the Undergraduate Coordinated Program in Dietetics (CP) is limited each year; therefore, a screening procedure is used to select the most qualified students for the available positions. Academic status (Grade Point Average), exam admission score, application letter, and references are the criteria used for screening. Admission to Arkansas State University does not guarantee admission into the undergraduate Coordinated Program in Dietetics. The online application process must be completed for entrance into the program.

The undergraduate CP integrates didactic (lecture/classroom) instruction with a minimum of 1080 supervised practice experience hours. The professional program is considered full time, begins in the fall semester only and is completed in two academic years, which includes one summer after the junior year. Enrollment is limited to 15 students.

A Bachelor of Science degree with Dietetics major is granted to students upon the successful completion of the program's 126 hours. The Master of Science in Nutrition and Dietetics (MSND) degree will accept the first cohort in May of 2023 and consists of a minimum of 36 semester hours beyond the Bachelor's degree. Upon successful completion of the MSND, students are eligible to take the national credentialing examination administered by the Commission on Dietetic Registration (CDR). After passing the examination, they become registered dietitians.

"Effective January 1, 2024, the Commission on Dietetic Registration (CDR) will require a minimum of a master's degree to be eligible to take the credentialing exam to become a registered dietitian nutritionist (RDN). In addition, CDR requires that individuals complete coursework and supervised practice in program(s) accredited by the Accreditation Council for Education in Nutrition and Dietetics (ACEND). In most states, graduates also must obtain licensure or certification to practice. Graduates who successfully complete the ACEND-accredited coordinated program at Arkansas State University are eligible to take the CDR credentialing exam to become an RDN. Anyone who graduates after December 31, 2023 will also need to complete a graduate degree in order to be eligible to take the CDR credentialing exam to become an RDN. Admission Requirements

In order to be eligible for application to the undergraduate Coordinated Program in Dietetics, the following requirements must be met, in addition to admission to Arkansas State University:

- Completion of program prerequisites with a minimum grade of "C" required in all courses
- Cumulative GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale of all college work attempted
- HESI A2 admission exam (see additional important information section for dates/times)
- English proficiency requirements, if foreign born

- All information should be typewritten with the possible exception of signatures and/or references. These could also be typewritten or electronically signed.

- FACE SHEET: The first page will be a FACE SHEET found in this packet. Fill it out completely. Please make it the first page of your PDF.

SECTION 2 - APPLICATION.

a. <u>Letter of Application</u>: The letter of application should be 1-2 pages in length, Times New Roman font, size 12 font and double-spaced with one-inch margins. Letter is scored according to style, mechanics and content.

The letter of application should include the following information:

- 1. Describe your reasons for selecting dietetics as a profession.
- 2. Describe why you think you will be an effective dietitian.
- 3. Describe your commitment to becoming a registered dietitian and the process you will employ to study and deliver satisfactory work to meet the required accreditation competencies.

SECTION 3 - TRANSCRIPTS. This part of the application should include a PDF copy of your unofficial transcripts from all post-high school institutions attended (*official transcripts will be needed if accepted into the program*).

SECTION 4 - PREREQUISITES. Complete the prerequisite form and include in this section. Put the grade next to the course(s) you have already completed and include the institution where you completed the course. If you need additional prerequisites, indicate when and where you will be taking the remaining courses.

SECTION 5 - REFERENCES. Arrange for three official reference forms to be completed by individuals who can address your ability to complete a professional program of study. Choose references who can evaluate you on most, if not all, of the areas on the list. Appropriate individuals could include a work supervisor, extra-curricular leader or professor in an academic course. A family member, relative or close friend should not provide a reference. The individuals submitting a reference form should email directly.

YOU SHOULD ONLY HAVE THREE (3) REFERENCES

SECTION 6 - IMMUNIZATIONS. Please submit proof you have received the required immunizations or at least the first dose of the series vaccinations (Hepatitis B, MMR). **Documentation must come from your healthcare provider.**

MMR (Measles, Mumps and Rubella)

Tetanus & Diphtheria (TDap) Current Tuberculin (TB) skin test

Submit all of the above materials together in ONE PDF document in the order listed. The program will not accept any incomplete applications. To increase your opportunity to be accepted for the program, please follow all directions carefully and submit the packet on time.

ADDITIONAL IMPORTANT INFORMATION

The undergraduate Coordinated Program in Dietetics requires that all CP students carry personal health insurance. This is mandatory. Students must provide hard copy proof of this to the Program Director's Office after they are accepted into the program. This must be provided **no later than August 31, 2022**. Thereafter, copies should be turned in each January as announced. Clear copies of both sides of your insurance card will suffice as proof.

The HESI A2 admission exam will be offered Wednesday, March 30 from 1-5 pm and Wednesday, April 6 from 1-5 pm. Please email dietetics@astate.edu to schedule a time to take the exam prior to submitting your application on April 18. Submit your Name, Student ID, and identify which day you prefer. If you are unable to attend one of the scheduled dates, please let us know as soon as possible and accommodations may be made available.

Verified Credentials

Based on recent legislation in Arkansas, students will be required to complete a <u>background check</u> <u>AFTER they receive conditional admission</u> into the Dietetics Program. Arkansas State University's College of Nursing and Health Professions works with Verified Credentials, Inc. to establish an acceptable screening procedure. The costs of the background checks are between \$50 and \$100. This fee is subject to change. A student who has a felony on his/her record may not be able to fulfill supervised practice hours in certain facilities and may not qualify for professional licensure.
