Application deadline: 10/17/25

- Students are notified of acceptance on or before November 1, 2025.
  - Needed for acceptance:
    - Lifecycle nutrition, nutritional biochemistry, nutrition assessment, food science, nutrition counseling, community nutrition, medical nutrition therapy, and an applied statistics course (junior level or higher)
    - Cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher on all work
    - Personal statement
    - Two letters of recommendation
- Students must notify the program of their acceptance/denial of their spot in the program by completing the cohort acceptance form by November 15, 2025.
- November 15, 2025 May 26, 2026: Students have this time to prepare.
- Student registration deadline: April 1, 2026
