- 1. 44 portfolios have been submitted for scoring to Pearson-fall 18, spring 19, fall 19
 - a. Content areas—ELED literacy, ELED math, MLED social studies, MLED language arts, K12 performing arts, K12 visual arts, Agriculture, K12 physical education, Secondary math, Secondary social studies, Secondary English, Secondary science
- 2. N=44
 - a. 47.7% passed (21)
 - b. 36.3% failed (16)
 - c. 15.9% condition codes (7)
- Condition codes (n=7)—edited video (1), did not respond to commentary prompts (4), missing artifact or referenced artifact not submitted (2), number of students did not meet the minimum group size (1), fewer than 3 lesson plans (1) incorrect file provided (1)
 - a. Rubrics with most condition codes—11(3), 12 (4), 13 (4), 14 (5), 15 (5)
 - b. *every rubric had at least one condition code
- 4. This semester Spring 2020
 - a. 42 vouchers to be submitted for this semester
 - b. 99 Capstone Interns across all programs on Jonesboro campus this semester
- 5. Overall impression at this stage
 - a. Looking across all the data, evaluating student submissions and discussions across programs, our issues seem to mainly center on writing and responding to the prompts. Good writing equals good scores. Clearly answering all prompts equals good scores

b. Our focus at this time with each of our programs will be to support student writing, provide constructive feedback when allowed, and encourage students to be as thorough as possible in their commentaries
