 - 393 Emergency Teaching Requests can be extended for 2 years
 - ▶ 433 Long term sub requests good for 2 semesters
 - Cannot hire someone without a degree; must work with Melissa Jacks concerning Act 1240 waiver
 - ➤ ADE will call on EPPs to assist districts with teacher shortages. These requests should mostly be for MAT students.
 - Currently, our capstone interns are NOT allowed to take on teaching jobs.
