COLLEGE OF EDUCATION AND BEHAVIORAL SCIENCE FACULTY SCHOLARSHIP AWARD 2021-2022 Application Criteria and Procedures

<u>Purpose</u>

The College of Education and Behavioral Science **Faculty Scholarship Award** provides financial support to the applicants department allowing a 3 hour release for scholarly activity.

Administration

Proposals are submitted to the chair of the COEBS Faculty Research Committee (via the Dean's Office for documentation of receipt) and reviewed by the committee.

Eligibility

Eligible applicants are those who hold tenured or tenure-track faculty appointments. In the evaluation process, extra consideration will be given for each of the following categories: (1) a first time recipient (2) a non-tenured applicant; (3) an applicant who has not received this award for at least 10 years.

Submission Process

Applications must be submitted to the Chair of the Committee (preferably via the Dean's Office) by May 1, 2021. Awards will be announced as soon as possible, following the deadline.

Application Format (Required)

- 1. Cover Sheet Complete the cover sheet electronically. Electronic signatures will be accepted.
- 2. Narrative Provide a brief project narrative. Please minimize the use of highly technical language, and express ideas in language and graphics accessible to faculty outside the field. Be concise and include:
 - a. Scope (what), significance (why), and objectives (how) of the project;
 - b. Brief review of related work by Pl and/or others, including theoretical framework;
 - c. Methodology/Plan of work, including analysis plan or evaluation/assessment plan;
 - d. Timeline of activities from initiation to completion,
 - e. Dissemination plan, including plans for state, regional and/or national dissemination;
- 3. Curriculum Vita Provide a CV (limited to 4 pages) for the applicant.
- 4. Supplementary Information Unless a project qualifies for exemption, Institutional Animal Care and Use Committee (IACUC) or Institutional Review Board (IRB) approval is necessary prior to the semester in which the award is to be used. If IACUC or IRB application has already been approved, please attach approval letter. No other supplementary materials will be accepted.

Evaluation Criteria

Each proposal will be evaluated on the merits of items 1 and 2.a-e, above using the posted *Project Scoring Form* Rubric. In the event of a single submission, the Rubric will still be used for evaluation of merit.

A preliminary report must be submitted to the Chair of the COEBS Faculty Scholarship Committee at the end of the term covered by release. The preliminary report should include a summary of activities and initial findings. A final report must be submitted by the end of the following semester covered by the release.
