QUALIFICATIONS FOR RECEIVING SCHOLARSHIP:

- Applicants must be from the Arkansas counties of Independence, Izard or Stone, who are seeking degrees is the
 Department of History, Department of Political Science, Department of Criminology, Sociology, and Geography, and
 the Department of English, Philosophy and World Languages.
- First preference given to students from Independence County and, among them, students from Cushman High School shall take precedence in the selection process.

- Applicant must possess a minimum grade point average of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale at the high school level and have scored at least 23 on the ACT, or an equivalent score on another college of admissions test, in order to be eligible.
- The scholarship may be awarded to qualified applicants in the following categories:
 - (1) Freshman and sophomore students majoring in any field within the College of Humanities and Social Sciences.
 - (2) Any junior or senior level student pursuing a major, in the following order of priority, in history, political science or English.
 - (3) Students pursuing a Master's Degree or a Doctor of Philosophy Degree majoring in history.
- After the above factors have been considered, financial need of the applicant shall be taken into consideration.
- Nothing herein shall preclude recipients from receiving assistance from other available scholarships or sources.

QUALIFICATIONS FOR MAINTAINING THE SCHOLARSHIP:

Scholarship may be automatically renewed during eight (8) consecutive academic semesters so long as the student meets all requirements set forth herein and maintains a 3.0 on a 4.0 scale or above grade point average. All recipients must be enrolled as full-time students during the academic semester of the award.
