

Act 1118

Arkansas Code (§ 6-16-1204 (e) (1) (B); commonly referred to as Act 1118) provides a maximum of six hours of reduced college tuition for students who are eligible for free/reduced lunches as determined by the National School Lunch Program (NSLP). Applications are available from and processed by the high school. Since the A-State tuition rate is already reduced for concurrent enrollment students, the tuition will be waived for a maximum of six hours of credit for Act 1118 eligible students. **The six hours of credit are the maximum available for the entire high school career.**

Courses eligible for Act 1118 must be:

1. On the Arkansas Course Transfer System (ACTS) list
2. Taught on the high school campus
3. Taught in the classroom (no web courses)
4. Taught by qualified high school faculty
