ABSTRACT

Art History is a sensorial discipline -- when working with objects, there is no substitute

for touch, and when examining archives, close looking is critical for the decipherment of difficult

to read letterforms. To complete projects in this discipline, travel is required -- to see and feel in

person. For the projects that will be completed through the support of this grant, the travel

demanded will take me to France and Spain. In Paris, I will work at the archives to complete the

transcription of five estate inventories that will be uploaded to the digital humanities project

DALME (https://dalme.org/). At the Musée de Cluny (Paris) and the Museo Lázaro Galdiano

(Madrid), I will look at some of the extent whistles from the late medieval and early modern

periods, which will become the subject of an article about this object-type. Lastly, I will examine

records from the Abbey of Saint Denis that relate to the mercantile event known as the Lendit

Fair. This research will become the basis for my second book.
