4. Reason for proposed change:

The proposed change is to add the practicum courses to the Master's of Science in Nutrition and Dietetics (MSND) to ensure that students have the required training to become a registered dietitian (see justification below). This change increases the total credit hours from 36 to 53.

Beginning January 1, 2024, students wanting to become a registered dietitian must complete a minimum of a graduate degree and 1,000 supervised practice hours. The Commission on Dietetic Registration and The Accreditation Council for Education in Nutrition and Dietetics (ACEND) will not require students to have an undergraduate degree in dietetics. The practicum courses will be changed to the master's level as part of the combined master's program, which incorporates coursework and supervised practice so that all requirements are completed at the master's level.
