• Coordinate Vocal Studies area by establishing a budget, revising curriculum, making studio assignments, hiring adjunct faculty, and creating standards-based assessment for juries and other performances.

Initiatives Within A-State Choral Program

- Led the Concert Choir on a ten-day performance tour of Portugal, including an appearance at the Lisbon International Music Festival.
- A-State Choral Invitational: A non-competitive, performance-based adjudication and clinic for statewide high school ensembles.
- During my first four years, nearly \$55,000 were added to the choral program's account at the ASU Foundation for special projects and student travel. Planned new annual winter concert to collaborate with instrumental ensembles from the university and community.
- Program Collaboration: Partnered with target campus and community organizations to highlight themes of each concert (Women and Gender Studies Office, Black Student Association, Campus Food Bank, etc.). These exchanges provided additional layers of meaning to the performance and grew our audiences to those who might not otherwise attend.
- Statewide Touring: After more than a decade hiatus, the A-State choirs increased their visibility around the state by visiting with and performing at high schools, junior highs, and elementary schools.
