Require a 2.75 GPA in all major field courses for admission to and retention in the BSE Physical Education Program offered in the Health, Physical Education and Sport Sciences Department.

4. Justification
During the last decade there has been an explosion of policy activity aimed at improving teacher quality. These policies have been established at federal, state, local, and institutional levels, and they focus on ensuring that teachers are qualified to teach the subject matter they are assigned or elect to teach. Requiring a 2.75 in all major field courses will have a positive impact on the academic content knowledge of our prospective physical education teachers.
