Provost Update/Q&A- Dr. Calvin White:

- Admitted more students as of today than we did all last year! Making sure we yield these students; 2500 and some change (admitted). We want to get them on campus. Waitlisted kids. Over 5,000 applicants (completed applications) 2.8 and above admitted, below 2.8 are waitlisted. Will go back in January and take a look at them. Arkansas Promise Plus is paying off. ACTs and GPAs are higher. Haven't rejected anyone.
- High school transcripts? Help the process. Moving to CommonApp, where that will send requests. It is a quarter million-dollar application. They will request and it will hopefully streamline the process. Accuplacer test is being done here as well. Trying to remove roadblocks. Our application process is more difficult than other schools and our competitors.
- Percentage online? -These numbers are all on campus. Removing the term AOS in next two years. We are 1 campus with 2 modalities. We want to remove the divide and allow students to take either but maybe place a limit (i.e. 3 hours per semester online). Need to increase fluidity.
- Andrea-Look at gen ed courses that are listed as online only for our face-to-face students.

- Sytems and outcomes misaligned. These systems were set up years ago, but no longer give the outcome/output that we need today. "Before you take down the fence, you have to understand why it was put up." Must change to deliver a better outcome of where we are today.
- For every 3 we admit, only 0.5 students come to our campus. Our highest yield is only 38%.
