All students must have a minimum ACT composite score of 19, an ACT reading score of 19, and a minimum high school GPA of 2.75 for admission to the CEP. An ASPIRE reading score of 428 OR ACCUPLACER reading score of 253 may be used as an equivalency for admission. Enrollment in English composition and math courses are subject to the required subtest scores noted below.
