TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF OCCUPANCY

When a student agrees to the conditions of this contract within the Housing Portal, this room and board contract immediately becomes a binding contractual obligation between the student and University Housing at Arkansas State University-Jonesboro. All information contained on the University Housing website and the Arkansas State University Student Handbook, is a legally binding adjunct which is incorporated into the contract by University Housing. It is the student's responsibility to become familiar with all provisions of this contract.

The University Housing contract begins on the first day that residential communities are open for the Fall term and ends on the last day that residential communities are open for the Spring term of the academic year as published in the University Academic Calendar, which includes any breaks or other periods of extension.

By entering your A-State ID number below you are signing your housing contract. When a student/staff member agrees to the conditions of this contract within the Housing Portal, this room and board contract immediately becomes a binding contractual obligation between the student/staff and University Housing at A-State. All information contained on the University Housing website and the Arkansas State University Student Handbook, is legally binding adjunct which is incorporated into the contract by University Housing. It is the student/staff's responsibility to become familiar with all provisions of this contract.

Safeguarding Personal Property

Residents desiring insurance protection must make their own arrangements for the necessary coverage. The university does not provide insurance covering the loss and damage (due to water leak, fire, etc.) to residents' personal effects. Students or their parents are encouraged to carry appropriate insurance to cover such losses. Residents are highly encouraged to invest in renter's insurance. Renter's insurance can be purchased through homeowners' policies or from independent companies specializing in residence hall insurance.

Special Interest Housing

Arkansas State University offers Living Learning Community (LLC) options to allow students to experience a unique living environment. Students will be placed with other students of similar interest and given programs that are focused towards that selection. Finalization of LLC locations are subject to change but no student will be assigned to a location without notification.

NOTE: Some areas have qualification or requirements before they can be assignments to the spaces.

If you have interest in one of the following special interest housing options, please read the qualifications. Assignments on some of these options will require the resident to qualify and/or depend on space available.

Community Name	Description
Art + Design	The Art and Innovation LLC is a collaboration between the Department of Art + Design and the College of Engineering and Computer Science. The LLC is open to all students majoring in any Art + Design major and to all majors in the College of Engineering and Computer Science. Students must remain enrolled in at least 6 hours of coursework in their major to be eligible to apply to the Art and Innovation LLC. Students will live in one of 42 large private bedrooms in this two-bedroom suite style accommodation. Each bedroom has an abundance of windows and is furnished with a twin bed, two desks, a chair, two nightstands, and an Ethernet port. The room also includes a large closet. Each floor has two study lounges. The Art and Innovation LLC is located on the 4th floor of Arkansas Hall overlooking the Wingate Center for 3-D Arts.
Honors (LLC 1,2, and 4)	Students interested in the Honors Living Learning Community must be accepted in the Honors College. The requirements include an ACT score of 28, a 3.5 GPA, and students must take one honors course per semester. The Honors Living Learning Community consists of four residential buildings and the Honors Smart Classroom, an academic building hosting Honors College classes. HLLC boasts two room styles. The freshmen/first-year room is designed for two students and each student is provided with an XL bed, dresser, desk, nightstand, chair, and closet. Only freshmen/first-year students may live in this type of room. The upper-class room is designed as a single room with a full size bed, dresser, desk, nightstand, chair, and closet. Students must have more than 20+ credit hours and be a second-year student to live in an upper-class room. Each room in HLLC shares a restroom with a neighbor in a true "suite" style. Each floor of HLLC has a common area lobby complete with comfortable seating and flat screen TVs (provided by the Honors College). HLLC has a capacity of 319, and rooms are in demand so early application and prepayment are strongly encouraged.
Music	The Music LLC is open to any music major or non-music major who is enrolled in applied performance lessons or an A-State instrumental/vocal ensemble. Students must remain enrolled in Music applied lessons or an instrumental/vocal ensemble to be eligible to apply to the Music LLC. Students will live in one of 42 large private bedrooms in this two-bedroom suite style accommodation. Each bedroom has an abundance of windows and is furnished with a twin bed, two desks, a chair, two night stands, and an Ethernet port. The room also includes a large closet. The Music LLC is located on the 5th floor of Arkansas Hall, a short and convenient walk to both the Fine
