In order to meet state and national standards, the programs have gone through revision and alignment to new standards. Our curriculum matrices indicate that ELCI 6423 can be eliminated while still being able to address all state and national standards. Additionally, all applicable concepts and standards are able to still be covered in Elementary Curriculum and Secondary School Curriculum courses which have been redesigned.
